

Talk by Dr Hillary Ash, Honorary Conservation Officer for Wirral Wildlife Wednesday, 11th May 2022 at 2pm

Her initial research project was an investigation into the way that native plants grow on industrial waste sites, and she has brought that expertise to her role as Honorary Conservation Officer for Wirral Wildlife, as well as in her professional career as a botanist carrying out surveys, creating management plans, and working on habitat creation in urban areas.
